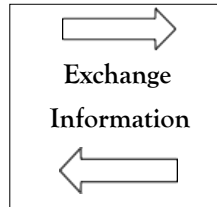

Photos you should take while at the scene

1. Other driver's ID
2. Other driver's insurance card
3. People involved in collision
 - a. yourself
 - b. passengers
 - c. other driver
4. Photos of all vehicles involved in the collision
 - Outside of Vehicle - Start with big picture, wide angle photos to show context and also close up shots to show damage detail. License plates.
 - Glass or car parts on the ground
 - Location - buildings, street signs, etc.
 - Inside of Vehicle - show what happened to the contents of the vehicle as a result of impact
